1. PURPOSE:

- a) The NCTA Maintenance Professional of the Year Award is presented to the person who is entrusted with the duties and responsibilities of maintenance supervision for his/her company. This award is to honor this person, who in the opinion of their peers is outstanding in their activities and accomplishments in maintenance and maintenance supervision in his/her company and in the State of North Carolina.

2. PRESENTATION:

The presentation to the individual will be made during the Annual Councils Conference of the North Carolina Trucking Association to be held in fall in October 2019.

3. SPONSOR:

The NCTA Technology and Maintenance Council will be the sponsor of this award, unless a member company expresses interest. Any member company can serve as sponsor for this award.

4. ELIGIBILITY FOR NOMINATION

- a) All nominees for the Maintenance Professional of the Year Award must be persons employed in a full-time capacity with a "member carrier" in the State of North Carolina for the past five (5) years performing maintenance or maintenance supervisor activities in a "carrier" member truck fleet.
- b) Nominees must be members in good standing of the NCTA Technology & Maintenance Council for the past five (5) years.
- c) A Maintenance Professional of the Year winner may be nominated again after five (5) years.
- d) A company that is a full "carrier" member in good standing with the North Carolina Trucking Association can only nominate a person if they (the company) have a SATISFACTORY rating issued by the US DOT Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration.
- e) Nomination for the Maintenance Professional of the Year Award may be made by any person.
- f) As a condition of being nominated, the nominees and the company in which they are employed must grant the North Carolina Trucking Association "Awards Committee" complete and full authority to investigate their records and any pertinent company records to determine that all qualifications are met. In turn, the Maintenance Professional of the Year Award Committee guarantees to hold the results of the investigation in strict confidence.
- g) Nominations which are unsuccessful in any given year may be re-submitted the following year, or any year thereafter, until successful, by bringing the information required for the nomination up-to-date as of the time of re-submission.
